Culture/Environmental Stewardship Day Camp
Ages 9-13

Chilkoot Tlingit Tribe will host a Culture/Environmental Stewardship Camp July 20-23, 2017. Overnight campers ages 14-18 years old and day campers from 9:30am to 4:30pm ages 9-13. The camp will be held at the Chilkoot Culture camp where no electricity, running water or plumbing exists. We'll be focusing on health of the mind, body, environment and community.

We combat drugs, alcohol, suicide and bullying by helping campers to better understand who they are and to appreciate where they live. We discuss how important it is to keep each other mindful of their roles as ambassadors of the land and culture and how to interact as contributing members of the community.

We encourage campers to stay active, fit and practice living a native lifestyle. We discuss staying positive and humble, eating healthy, respecting the laws of nature and reciprocity between the raven and eagle clans. We sing and dance together to connect us to our ancestors through language and story.

We encourage all members of the community to participate, as learning about each other encourages tolerance of our differences.

We will have limited staff, therefore request that parents with children who need additional supervision, please provide a plan to keep your child safe.

APPLICATION DEADLINE: July 5th, 2017.

If you have multiple children attending, we request that you fill out a separate application for each child. We suggest a donation to the camp, if possible.

Day camp will be from 9:30am – 4:30pm. Parents will need to arrange transportation for day campers.

Camp will end on July 23rd at 2pm with an open house to follow until 5:30 pm.

_____ I will refrain from fighting or any other actions that may cause bodily, emotional or physical harm to others.

_____ I understand that electronics, including cell phones, are prohibited at Culture Camp unless you are designated to document Culture Camp. Cell phones will be available with Counselors for Emergency use only.

_____ I understand that any inappropriate behavior and language will not be tolerated.

_____ I agree to obey all camp boundaries and other safety rules as instructed by Culture Camp Staff, volunteers and Elders.

_____ I will be responsible for all consequences of my behavior.

_____ I agree that Chilkoot Tlingit Tribe, and employees thereof, will not be held liable for any damage(s) that may occur to electronics and personal items that campers have brought with them.

_____ I understand that foul language, drugs, alcohol, tobacco, fireworks, matches, cigarette lighters, knives, firearms, ammunition and explosive materials or items that would endanger people, pets, wildlife, or property are not only illegal for me to be in possession of but are all considered contraband items. If I am found in possession of any of these sorts of items, my parent/legal guardians may be notified, I could immediately be dismissed from Culture Camp.

_____ I understand that dismissal from this Culture Camp for breaking any portion of this agreement could affect my chances of attending future Culture Camps hosted by the Chilkoot Tribe.
