



**Job Description:** Baker/AM Prep Cook

**Summary**

*Taste of Deishú* is a tribally-owned and managed restaurant and event space in Haines (Tlingit: Deishú), Alaska. We seek an experienced Baker/Prep Cook for the summer 2025 Season (May-October). The ideal candidate will have experience baking professionally, is adaptable, and loves using local ingredients. The Baker/Prep Cook will also be responsible for assembling grab-and-go menu items and helping the AM barista open the café for the day.

**Responsibilities**

- Bakes a daily selection of baked goods to be sold during AM cafe and lunch services: ‘daily standbys, & seasonal specials
- Assembles grab-and-go menu items daily. Daily grab-and-go menu items and quantities will be communicated to Baker by Manager(s)
- Bakes dessert items for Dinner Menu as needed
- In collaboration with other restaurant shifts, help maintain sourdough routine
- At the end of shift, clean-up from baking/grab-and-go prep shift
- Document items need to be restocked/ordered.
- Helps Barista open; stocking supplies, writing menu, brewing coffee, etc
- Helps train Assistant Baker. This includes teaching standardized recipes provided or designed by Baker and training in all other Baker duties. The long-term goal is that the Assistant Baker could stand-in as Baker after enough training
- Maintains a professional and positive work environment
- Assists in managing menu that reflects tribal priorities, food sovereignty initiatives and seasonal variability
- Adheres to relevant state, local and federal food sanitation codes and best practices
- Bakes pre-established menu items *and* bring new creative ideas to the menu
- Has current Alaska Food Handlers Card and follows Alaska DEC rules and regulations regarding food safety

**Skills and Qualifications**

- Experience baking professionally and independently
- Effective working autonomously as well as part of a team
- Enjoys creating new recipes using local food ingredients
- Willingness to work flexible hours
- Comfortable standing on feet for up to eight hours and lifting 50+ pounds
